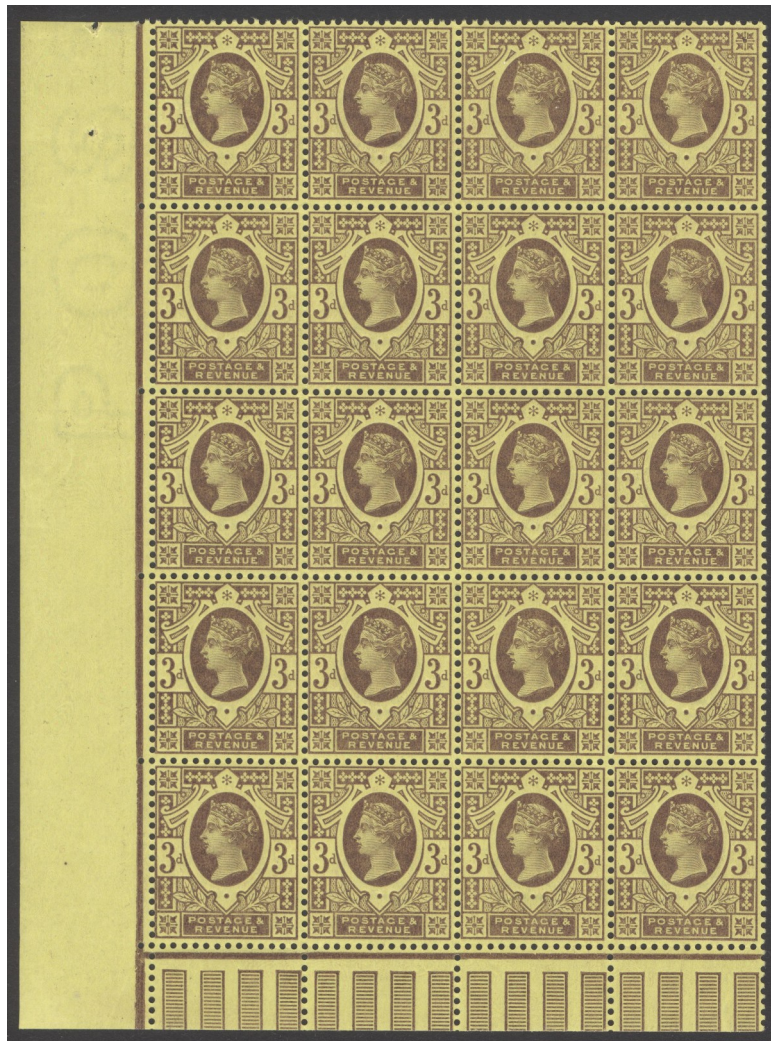

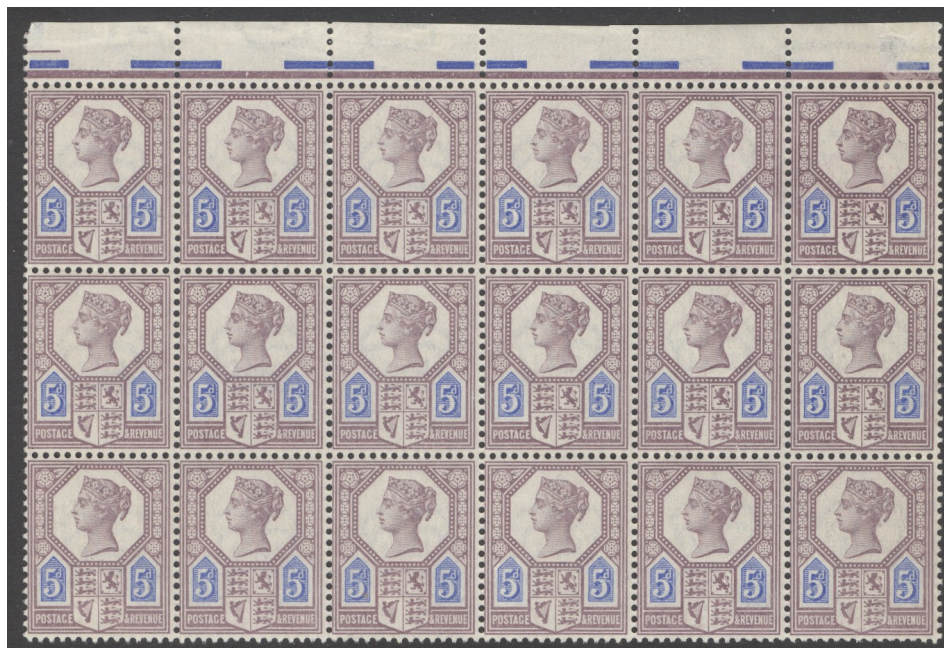

Corner marginal block of 20 in setting 1 showing the small watermark cross at bottom right, indicating that this is from the bottom right of the sheet. The broken division ornament in both margins suggest that this is probably 20-set issue, and hence from setting 1A. Very few 'panes' of 20 of this setting have survived, if indeed there are any others. Extremely rare – possibly unique.

SG 211 1887-1900. 1/- dull green bottom right corner marginal pane of 20, hinged on 2 stamps, others unmounted mint CAT £8700 as 4 blocks & a strip of 4. An extremely rare, possibly unique multiple. £5500
